

HRSA Traineeship Grant Continues until 2023!!

- As of July 1, 2019 we have approval for a four-year HRSA Advanced Nursing Education Workforce federal grant!!!! This means you could receive support for your FNP and/or PMHNP education, including tuition, books, and living expenses!!!
- Awards in Fall and Spring semesters. (Applications accepted in the summer for Fall semester and in Fall for the Spring semester. No summer funding available.)
- Look click on the School of Nursing website or the INTUNE HRSA grant website for instructions on how to apply. You must apply for each semester that you would like funding support.
- Application deadlines enforced! Apply early!

Who: UT Tyler FNP students (especially from rural/underserved areas); What: recruiting and graduating more skilled, practice-ready, team-based FNPs to become employed in rural/underserved (R/US) areas; When: traineeship applications <u>NOW OPEN FOR Spring</u> <u>2020</u>; Where: Medically Underserved Areas (MUAs), Medically Underserved Populations (MUPs), or Health Professional Shortage Areas (HPSAs); Texas is filled with these types of sites; Even if you don't know where you are going to work yet, or you don't know if your clinical practice site/preceptor qualifies to be part of the grant, go ahead and apply! Why: to increase the numbers of diverse FNP students recruited to/graduating from UT Tyler, and to increase their employment in R/US areas; to improve access to quality healthcare of MUA/MUP/HPSA populations; and, to develop primary care training sites for clinical training in R/US areas/populations for UT Tyler FNP students.

This grant specifically applies to clinical precepted practice in the rural and underserved areas of East Texas while in school and requires one year of employment within the same demographic upon graduation.

Multiple sites available.
